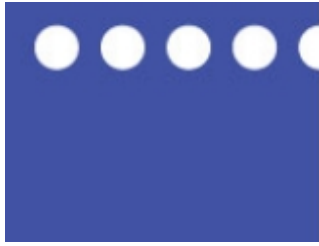

Sample Questions from WSSCA's 25-point Checklist

1. Does the school have a crisis plan?
2. Is access to the school adequately controlled?
3. Has the school staff received security training?
4. Does the school have an adequate camera system?



5. Is the school in compliance with state statute #118.07 (Act 309)?

Are you PREPaREd?

Comprehensive Safety = Physical and Psychological Safety

PREPaRE training is ideal for schools committed to improving and strengthening their school safety and crisis management plans and emergency response.

Outcomes: All individuals who receive PREPaRE training will gain a better understanding of the organization and function of a comprehensive safety and crisis team (Workshop 1) and/or the knowledge and skills necessary to meet the mental health needs of students and staff in the aftermath of a crisis (Workshop 2). Audience: School crisis teams, school mental health personnel, administrators, community liaisons, school resource officers, and any other professionals and support staff that will be involved in crisis planning/preparation.
