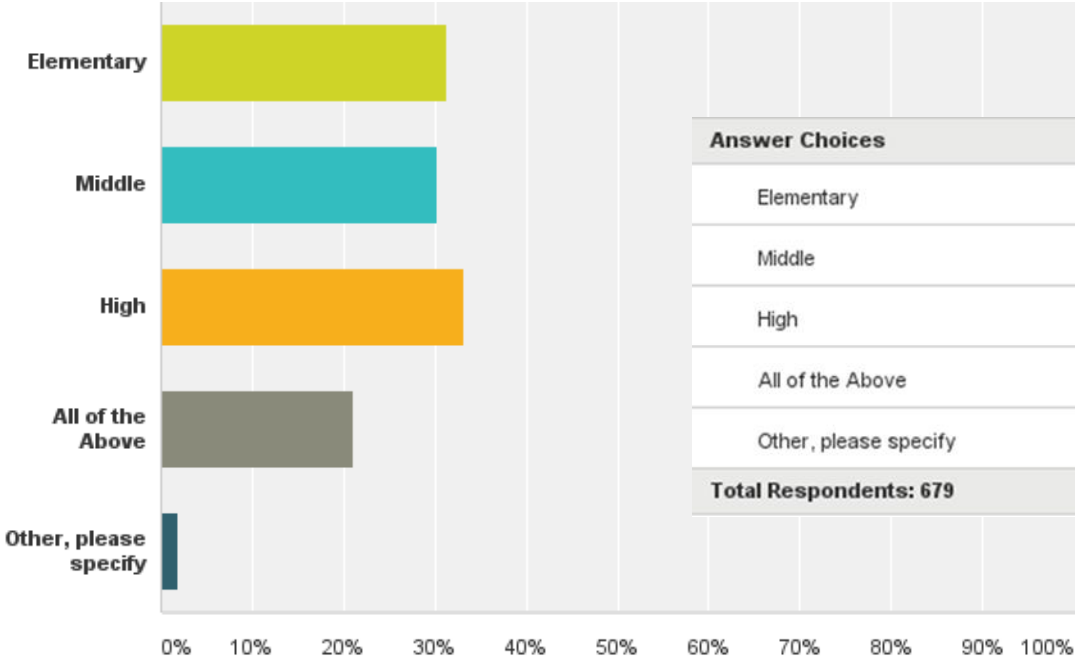

Q2: What level do you most often serve: (Select all that apply)

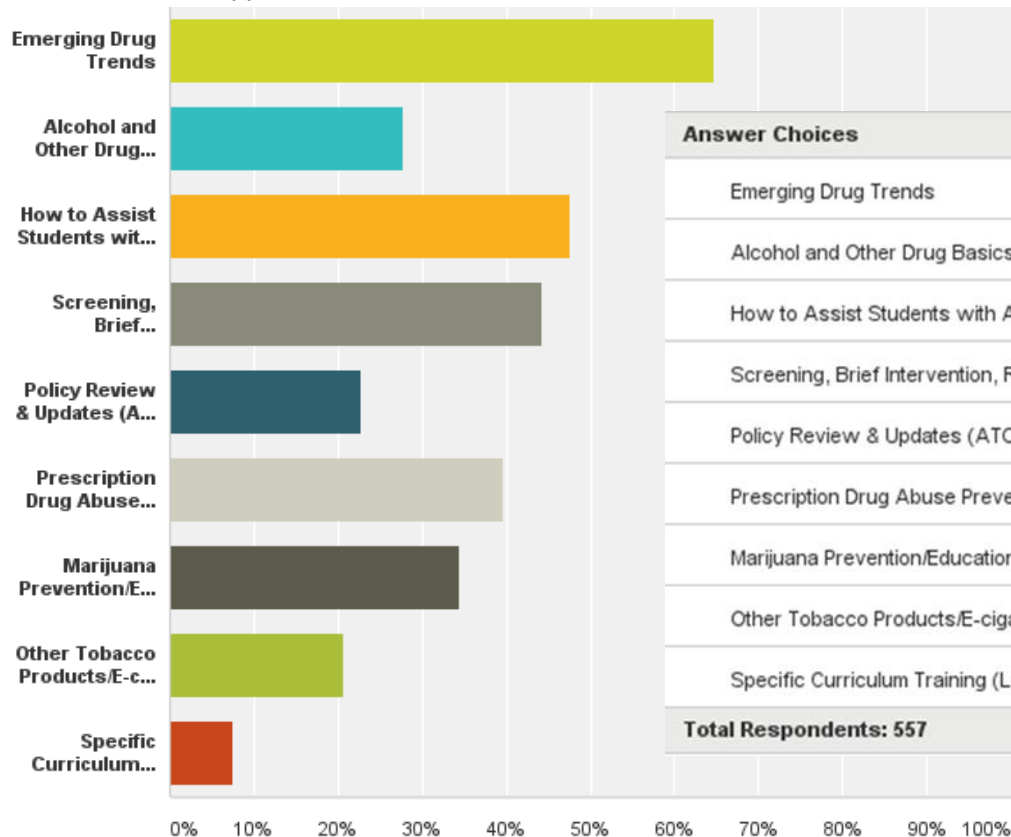

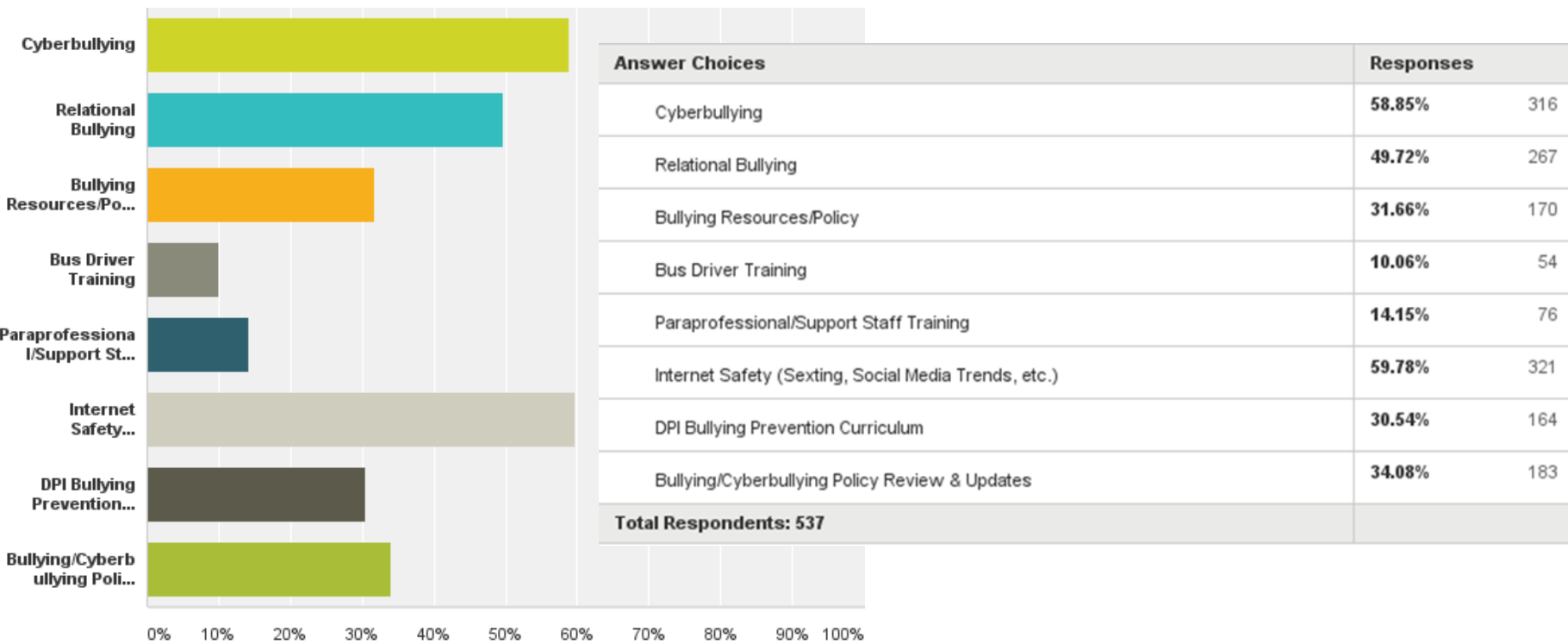

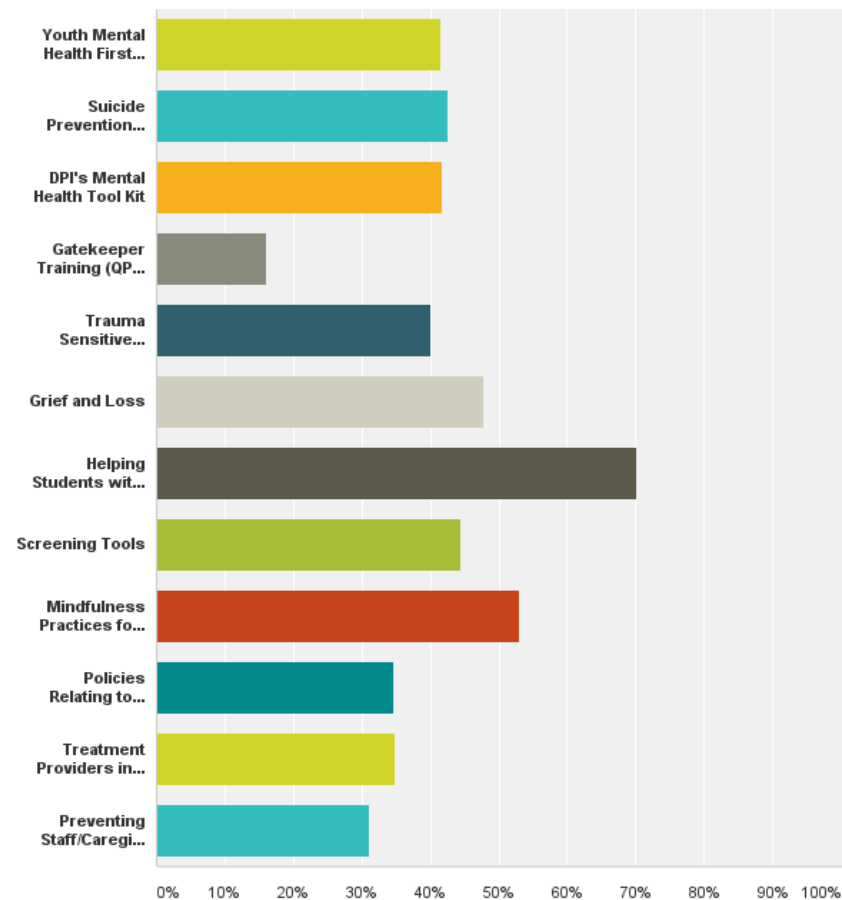

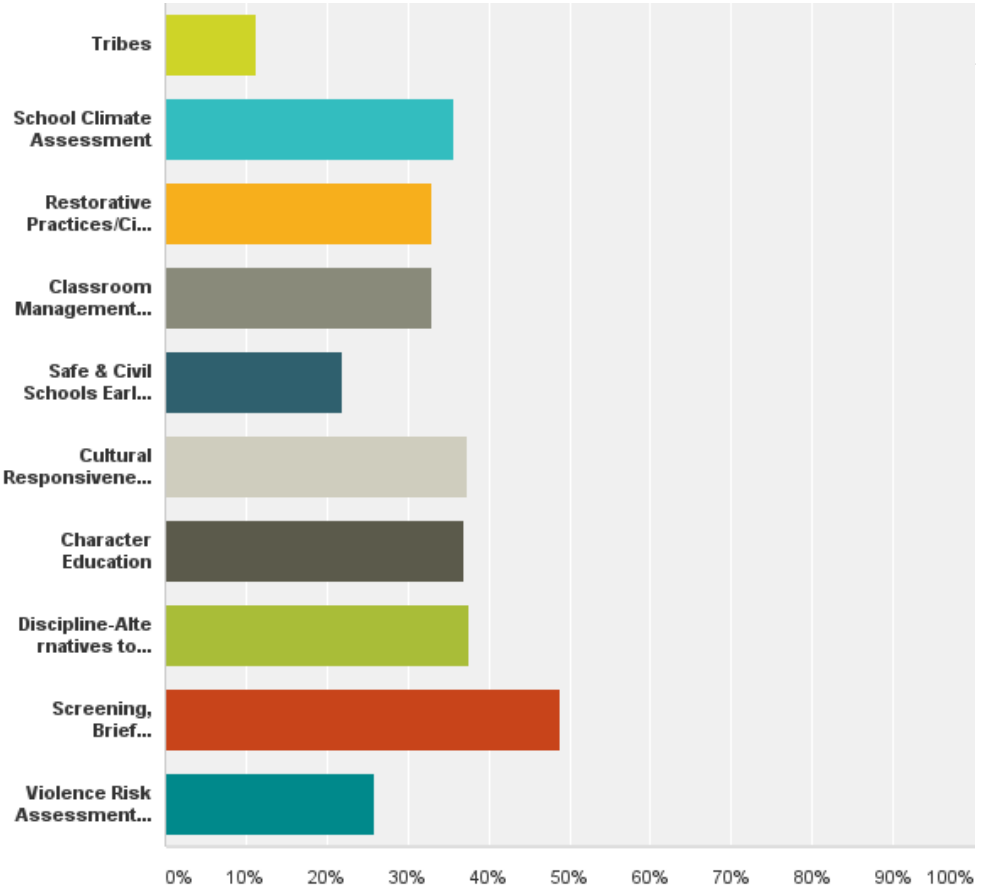

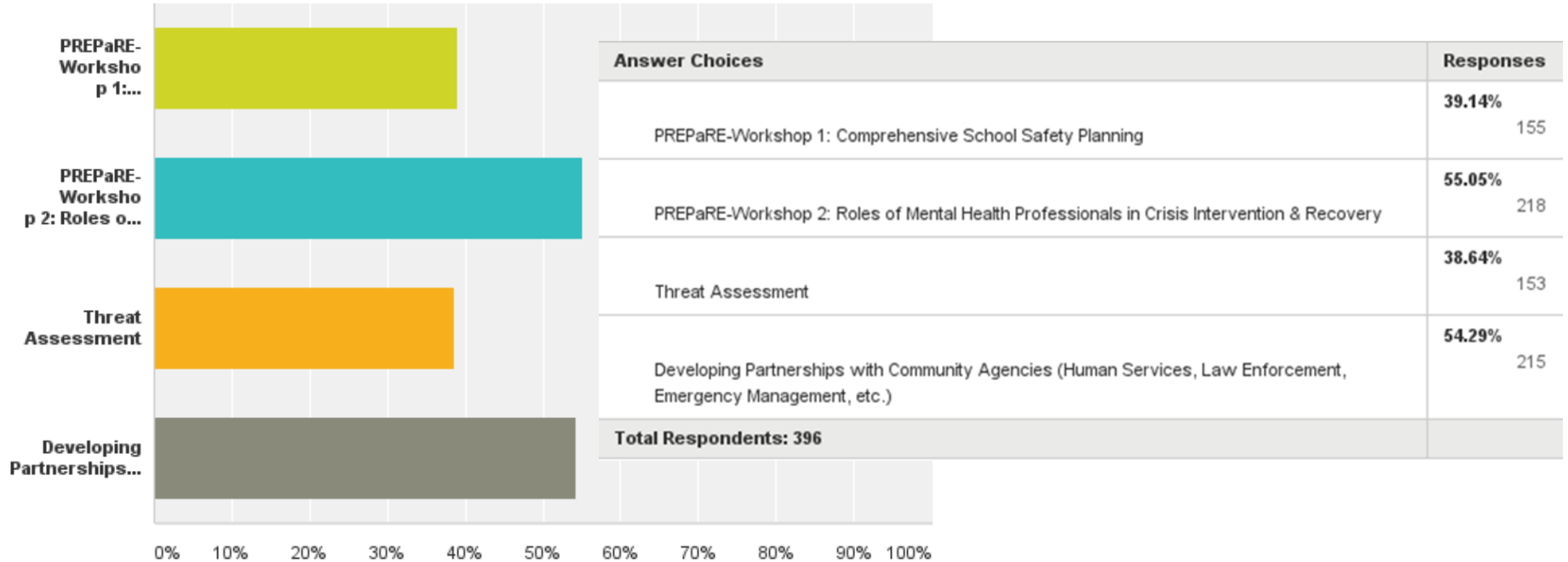

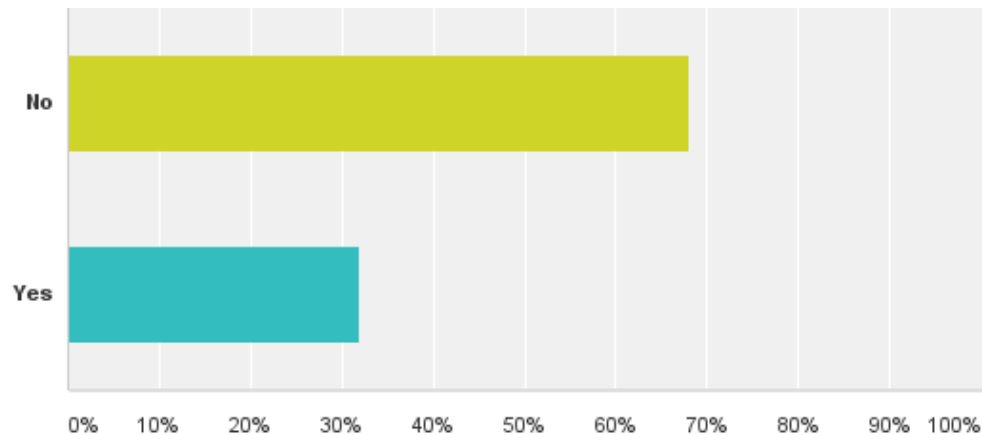
Q7: School Safety: Please check training topics that you would attend.(Select all that apply.)

Q8: Are you interested in bringing students to training (Leadership, Bullying Prevention, Peer Education, etc.)?

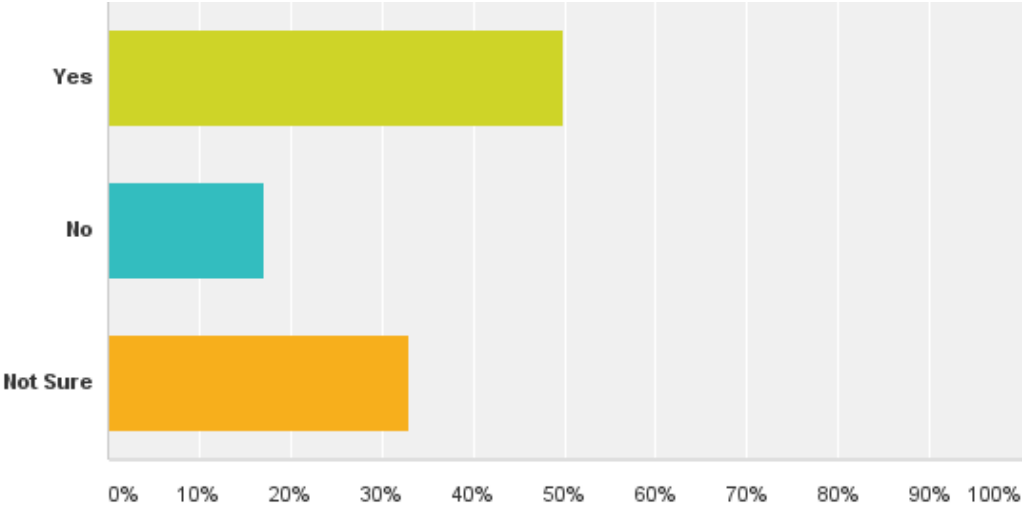

Q9: Are you interested in participating in Shareshops/Educational Networking Meetings (ATOD, Counseling, or other) by CESA or region?

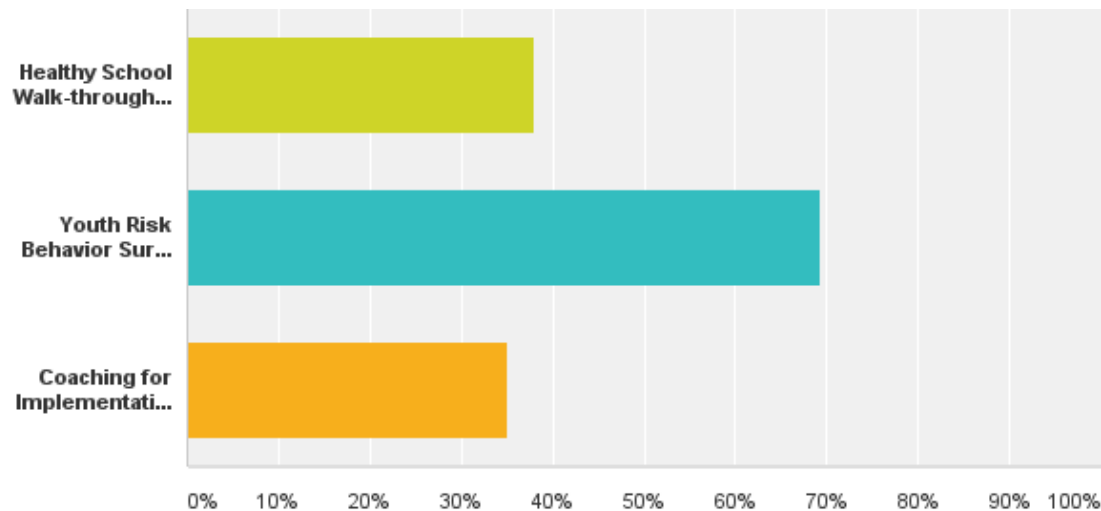

Q10: Please select any technical assistance or in-district services that your school would be interested in receiving.

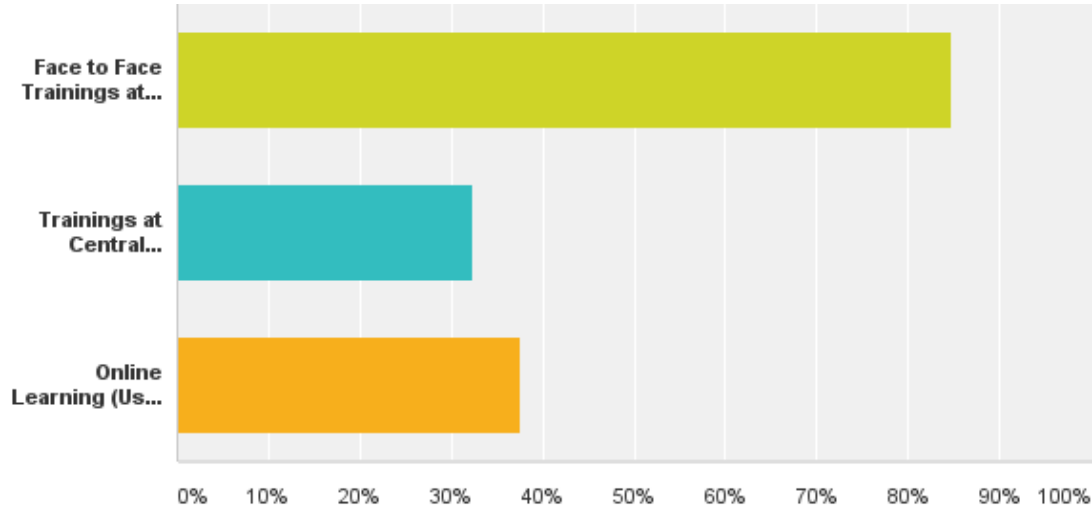

Q11: I prefer which of the following: (Select all that apply)

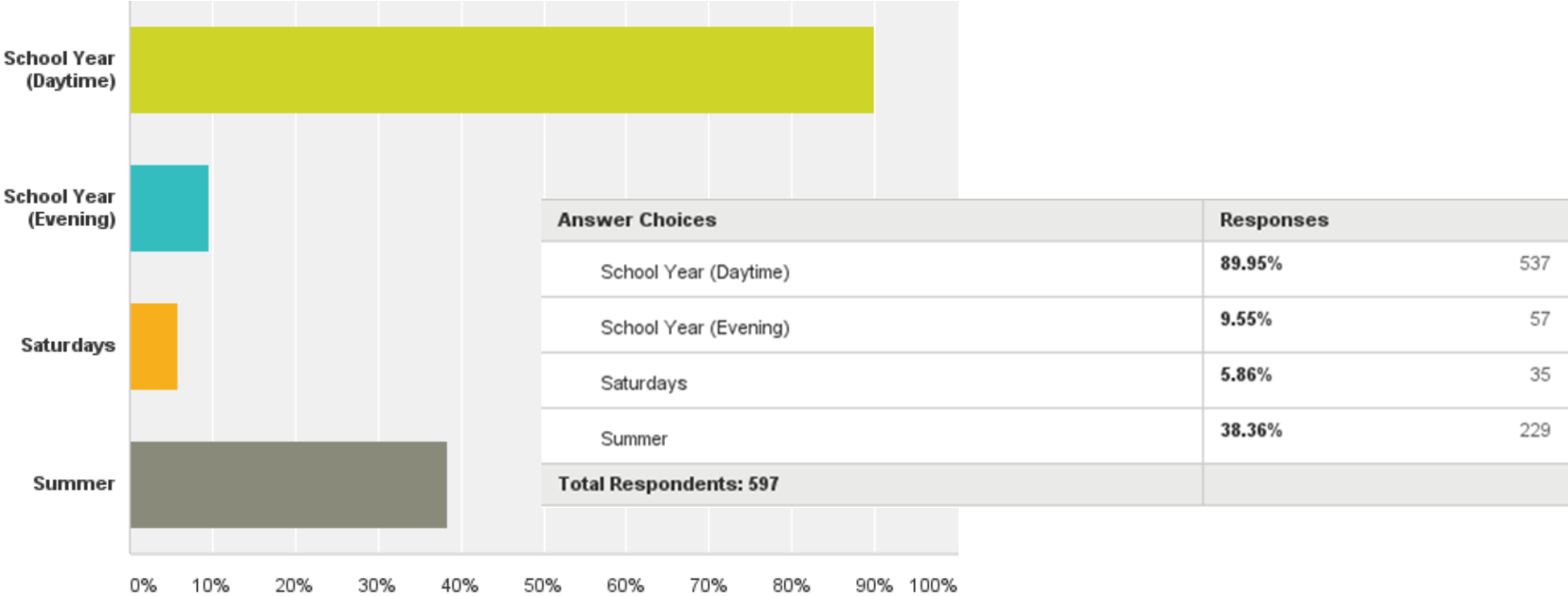
