Methodology:

Survey conducted online via Survey Monkey May 1-17, 2013

335 Participants from CESAs 1-12

Top 12 Needs Identified

- 1. Crisis Planning-Response & Recovery 75%
- 2. Cyberbullying 70%
- 3. Emerging Drug Trends 64%
- 4. Relational Bullying 61%
- 5. Brief Interventions/Motivational Interviewing 61%
- 6. Crisis Planning-Prevention, Mitigation, & Preparedness 61%
- 7. Threat Assessment 59%
- 8. Self-Injury 58%
- 9. Depression 58%
- 10. Screening Tools 55%
- 11. Mental Health Toolkit 54%
- 12. Suicide Prevention Strategies 52%

Other Findings:

- 165 people (54%) are interested in educational networking meetings by CESA or region.
- 187 people (62%) are interested in bringing students to a variety of trainings related to bullying prevention, leadership, and peer mediation.
- Variety of other comments and feedback on how to best meet safe and healthy school needs, etc. topics, locations, use of technology, etc.
- Distance is a barrier for many, suggestions of more online training or a more central location.
